### Pyjama Day

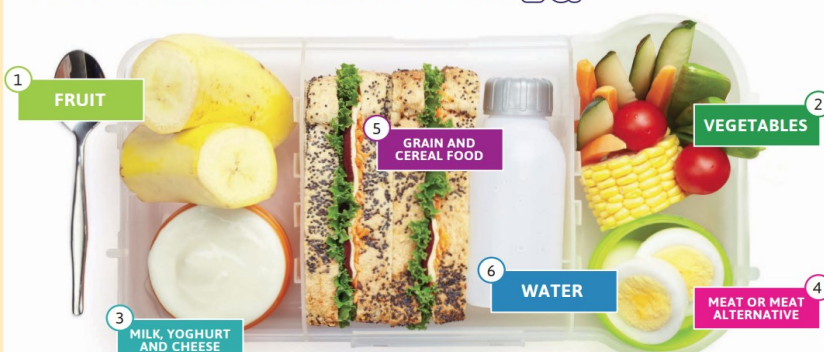
The SRC team will be holding a PJ Casual Dress Day on **Friday 15<sup>th</sup> August** to raise money for refrigerated bubble taps.
