### Judicial College of Victoria Visit

A few weeks ago, we were honoured to welcome members of the Judicial College of Victoria to Mildura Primary School. The visiting group included representatives from the Supreme Court of Victoria and New South Wales, the County Court of Victoria, the Children's Court, and magistrates from across the state.

Their visit focused on observing how we embed Indigenous perspectives through our Barkindji language and culture lessons. Our school captain, Jaz Baxter, warmly greeted the guests, and our girls' dance group gave a wonderful performance to open the morning.

Mr Johnson then shared a classroom lesson and spoke about how Mildura Primary School incorporates cultural learning into daily practice. It was a privilege to showcase our work as the only primary school in the district selected for this visit.

### E-scooter Road Rules

Tougher penalties as e-scooters are made permanent.

#### e-scooter riders cannot

- Ride on the footpath
- Use a mobile phone while riding
- Ride while under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- Carry passengers or animals or ride in tandem
- Ride a high-speed e-scooter, one capable of more than 25 km/h
- Ride on roads that have a speed limit over 60 km/h



#### e-scooter riders must

- Be aged 16 years and over
- Not exceed the maximum speed of 20 km/h
- Ride only on shared paths and roads that have a speed limit up to 60 km/h
- Wear a helmet at all times
- Follow traffic rules
- Use lights and reflectors


