eSafety and Social Media – Important Information for Families

At Mildura Primary School, student safety and wellbeing—both online and offline—are always a priority. The **eSafety Commission** has recently released updated advice about children using social media platforms, and we would like to share this information with our families.

From 10th December, several popular social media platforms are now considered **age-restricted**, meaning children under 16 years of age will not be able to create or keep accounts.

This is **not a ban**—it is a **delay** designed to protect young people while they continue to develop the maturity and skills needed to navigate online spaces safely.

Why delay access until 16?

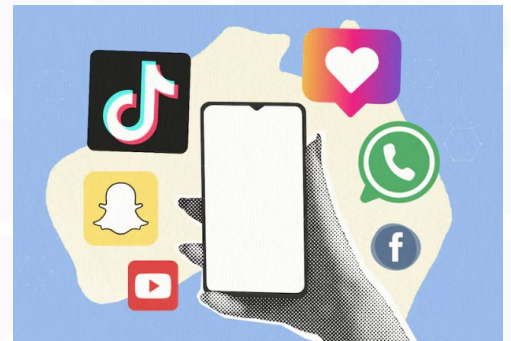
It reduces exposure to:

- addictive design features
- constant alerts and pressure to respond
- harmful or distressing content
- reduced sleep, increased stress and anxiety

This change means parents no longer need to decide whether their child should have access—families can confidently say “**not yet**” without children feeling they are missing out.
