Parent/Carer/Guardian Opinion Survey

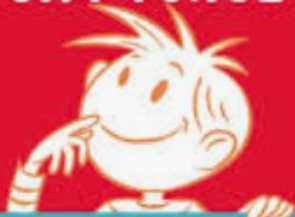

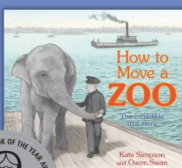

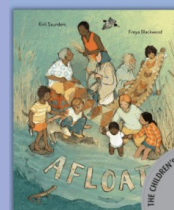
