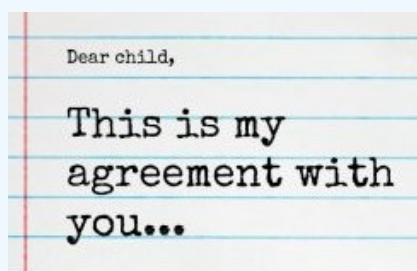
## Helping Our Children Stay Safe Online

Here are some simple but powerful strategies to help our children stay safe online.

### Set Some Ground Rules

It's helpful to have clear rules about when and how devices are used. Talk through these rules with your child and explain the reasons behind them. When children help set the boundaries, they're more likely to follow them.

You might like to create a *Family Tech Agreement* — a shared set of expectations for how technology is used at home. Visit [esafety.gov.au](https://esafety.gov.au) to find a simple template that suits your family.



### Keep Devices in Shared Spaces

Place computers, tablets or phones in areas where you can easily check in. This helps you stay involved and gives your child more opportunities to talk to you about what they're doing online .

## Top 5 online safety tips for kids

1

Set up your device to protect your information.

2

Explore safely and tell an adult if you see anything online that makes you feel yuck.

3

Limit who can contact you when you're playing games.

4

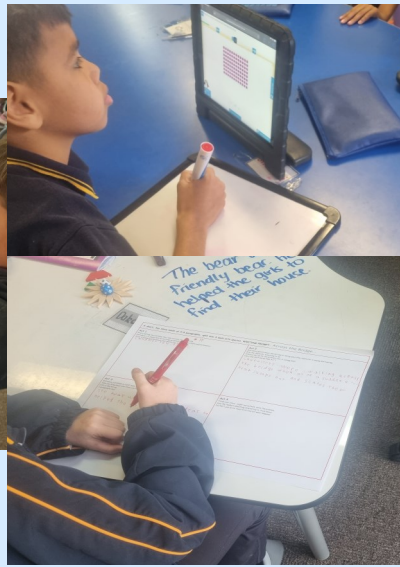
Stop all contact with anyone online who asks you to do anything you don't want to do. Report and block them.

5

Ask for help if anything online is bothering you.



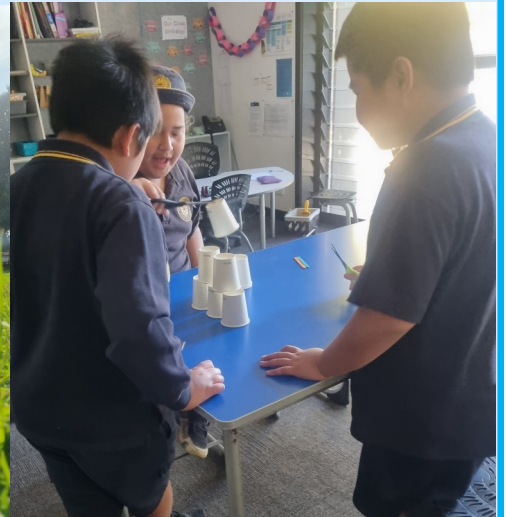




The **year 5** classes have been busy working on building their literacy skills by developing their reading comprehension skills, writing narratives and zines about something they're passionate about.
